(Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 203.) Presented by Representative COLLINGS of Portland. Referred to the Joint Standing Committee on Judiciary. Public Hearing 02/28/22. Final Disposition: Died On Adjournment 05/09/22.
