An Act To Encourage Job Growth in the Forest Products Sector through Tax Incentives. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 203.) Presented by Representative EVANS of Dover-Foxcroft. Referred to the Joint Standing Committee on Taxation. Public Hearing 02/01/22. Majority (OTP-AM) Report Accepted 04/15/22. Amended by: CA H-944, SA/CA S-561. Final Disposition: Enacted. (Veto Sustained 05/09/22).
