(Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 205.) Presented by Representative TALBOT ROSS of Portland. Referred to the Joint Standing Committee on Judiciary. Public Hearing 02/08/22. Majority (OTP) Report Accepted 03/29/22. Final Disposition: Finally Passed, Signed 04/12/22, RESOLVE, Chapter 149.
