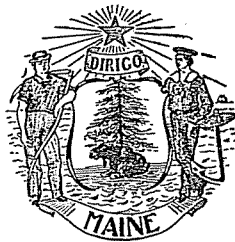

STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT

TO REVISE AND CONSOLIDATE THE PUBLIC LAWS
OF THE STATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES IN LEGISLATURE ASSEMBLED, in the manner stated under the several titles and chapters as follows, not including marginal and other notes, or references:

The foregoing act, from chapter one to chapter one hundred and forty-five, both inclusive, shall take effect and become law on the first day of January, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and four.

IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, September 1, 1903.

This bill, including chapters one to one hundred and forty-five, inclusive, having had three several readings, passed to be enacted.
