STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY.

AN ACT

TO REVISE AND CONSOLIDATE THE PUBLIC LAWS
OF THE STATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MAINE,
in the manner stated under the several titles and chapters, not
including abstracts of sections, notes, or references:

The foregoing act, from chapter one to chapter one hundred sixty-five, both inclusive, shall take effect and become law on the tenth day of November, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred thirty.
