§ 3161. Examiner; compensation

For the enforcement of chapters 281 to 289, the commissioner is authorized to appoint, subject to the Personnel Law, an examiner, who shall receive in addition to his salary his necessary traveling expenses. The salary, traveling expenses and all expenses of administration and enforcement of said chapters shall be paid out of such amounts as the Legislature may appropriate. Fees received from licenses issued under said chapters shall be paid to the Treasurer of State for deposit in the General Fund.

§ 3162. Penalties

Whoever either individually or as the officer or employee of any corporation or association violates any of the provisions of chapters 281 to 289 shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500 or by imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or by both.
