3501. Willful concealment of merchandise.

§ 3501. Willful concealment of merchandise

Whoever, without authority, willfully conceals the goods or merchandise of any store, while still upon the premises of such store, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100, or by imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or by both. Goods or merchandise found concealed upon the person shall be prima facie evidence of a willful concealment.
