#### CHAPTER 119

#### SUBVERSIVE ACTIVITIES

Sec. 3651. Penalty.

### § 3651. Penalty

Any person who advocates, aids or takes any active part in the overthrow by force and violence of the Government of the United States or the State of Maine or any political subdivision thereof is guilty of a felony and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by imprisonment in the State Prison for not more than 5 years or by a fine of not more than \$5,000, or by both.
