## CHAPTER 17

## UNION SCHOOLS

Sec.

521. Establishment; management and authority.

522. Union schools; apportionment.

**§ 521. Establishment; management and authority**

Adjoining towns, upon the written recommendation of the school committees of said towns, may by concurrent action maintain union schools for the benefit of parts of said towns or may establish such schools, and shall contribute to their support each in proportion to the number of scholars in each of said towns attending such schools. Said schools shall be under the management of the school committee of the town in which their school-houses are located.

**§ 522. Union schools; apportionment**

Amounts due from the State on account of union elementary schools shall be paid to the town in which said school is located and the amounts to be contributed by each town for the maintenance of such school shall be determined by the superintending school committees of the said towns. Amounts apportioned on account of union high schools shall be paid to the towns maintaining said schools in proportion to the aggregate attendance of pupils resident of each of said towns.
