CHAPTER 23

SALE OF MALT AND MALT SYRUP

Sec.

951. Restrictions and penalties.

§ 951. Restrictions and penalties

Malt or malt syrup shall not be sold, except for bakery or industrial purposes, by any person, or sold as a beverage except as malt beverages already provided for by law or in any form of malt beverage which contains 1% or less of alcohol by volume.

Any person selling malt or malt syrup, except for bakery or industrial purposes, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500 or by imprisonment for less than one year.
