MINIMUM DISTANCE FOR CLEARANCE

861. Clearances set by Public Utilities Commission.

§ 861. Clearances set by Public Utilities Commission

The Public Utilities Commission shall have the right to prescribe a minimum distance for clearance of any structure, pole or other object over or beside any railroad track. This section shall not apply to any structure, pole or other object in existence over or beside any railroad track on or before September 1, 1955.
