STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND THIRTY-THREE.

AN ACT relating to Prosecutions for Libel, and to Pleadings in Actions for Libel and Slander.

- SEC. 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and
- 2 House of Representatives, in Legislature as-
- 3 sembled, That in every prosecution for writing
- 4 and publishing any libel, it shall be lawful for
- 5 any defendant upon trial of the cause, to give in
- 6 evidence in his defence the truth of the matter
- 7 contained in the publication charged as libellous:
- 8 Provided always, that such evidence shall not
- 9 be a justification, unless on the trial it shall be

- 10 further made satisfactorily to appear, that the
- 11 matter charged as libellous was published, with
- 12 good motives and for justifiable ends.

Sec. 2. Be it further enacted, That in all

2 actions of the case, for writing and publishing

3 any libel, and in all actions for slander wherein

4 the defendant or defendants may plead the gen-

5 eral issue, and also in justification that the words

6 written and published or spoken were true, such

7 plea in justification shall not be held or taken as

8 evidence that the defendant or defendants wrote

9 and published or spoke such words or made such

10 charge. Nor shall such plea of justification, if

11 the defendant or defendants fail to establish it,

12 be of itself proof of the malice of such words or

13 charge, but the jury shall decide upon the whole

14 case, whether such special plea was or was not

15 made with malicious intent, any law or usage to

16 the contrary notwithstanding.
