A LIST of the Returns made to the Office of the Secretary of State by the Selectmen of the several Towns and the Assessors of the several Plantations, and the City of Portland (under a Resolve of the Legislature, passed February 27th 1833, entitled a "Resolve for ascertaining the expense of making and repairing Roads and Bridges within this State") specifying in separate columns, against the respective names of said towns, plantations and city, the amount expended in labor and cash during four years, commencing on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-nine, and ending on the thirty-first day of December, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-two, and what price was allowed for labor upon an average during said term," so far as said Returns have been received.

By the Resolve before mentioned, it was made the duty of the Selectmen of the several Towns, the Assessors of the several Plantations, and the City of Portland, to make the returns from them required, on or before, the first day of October, 1833 ; and after receiving said returns, the Secretary of State was directed to prepare a list thereof, and to cause five hundred copies of the same to be printed and laid before the Legislature at the commencement of the present session. This however could not be done at so early a day as was contemplated, on account of the remissness of officers of towns &c. in making their Returns to this Office, And as Returns have been daily coming in, the printing of said List has been delayed until this time, in order that it might be as complete as possible. The column on the right hand shows the time at which the returns were received.
