*To the House of Representatives of the State of Maine:*

In compliance with the call of the House, of the 12th of January, I have the honor to transmit an abstract of the transactions of this Department, from the separation of Maine from Massachusetts, to the first day of January, A. D. 1835. This document embraces the sales of land, the price of each particular tract, and the average price per acre, for each year, the yearly expenses of the Department of every description, the amount annually paid into the State's Treasury, and a list of all securities on hand. I have been unable in the short time that I have had charge of this Office, to ascertain the ability of many of those indebted, to meet the demands against them, and cannot, with any degree of certainty, judge what portion of them are altogether unavailable. From my present knowledge,

however, I am of opinion, that about five thousand dollars, mostly in executions of long standing, and trespass notes, taken many years ago, will be altogether lost. There are also notes to the amount of from ten to fifteen thousand dollars, which will not be paid, but on which no actual loss will be sustained, as the land for which they were given, is mortgaged to the State. Most of the small notes were given for settling land, and although the greater part of them will be paid, they cannot be relied upon at maturity.

The average price per acre, of sales for the respective years, may lead to very erroneous conclusions, unless the quality is taken into consideration. In the years eighteen hundred and thirty, thirty one, and thirty two, there were large sales of the most valuable timber lands, whereas, sales the two past years, with the exception of about three thousand acres, have been confined to land of an inferior quality.

I have been compelled to draw a portion of the information herewith communicated, from the records of deeds, and the settled accounts of the Agents, deposited in the Secretary's Office. The books in which it should have been contained, are supposed to have been burnt, when the Office of the late Agent was consumed by fire, in the autumn of eighteen hundred and thirty three. It is not impossible, therefore, that there may be some omissions, yet it is believed that the following schedules are as correct, as from the circumstances, could be reasonably expected.
