IN SENATE, February 20, 1885.

The **Joint Standing Committee on Banks and Banking**, to whom was referred an order directing them to “**Report the number of Banks and increased Capital which they have reported the present Session—the amount of Capital of each—where located—and the present amount of Bank Capital in those places,**” have had the same under consideration and ask leave to **Report :**

That the number of **Banks** for which said **Committee** have reported that **charters of incorporation** should be granted, is **Eight.**

That the number of Banks, in favor of the increase of the Capital of which, they have reported, is Five.

The new Banks to be located at Bangor, are the

People's Bank, Capital,	- - - -	\$100,000
Lafayette Bank,	" - - - -	100,000
City Bank,	" - - - -	100,000
Franklin Bank,	" - - - -	100,000

		\$400,000

The Bank Capital there before was 400,000

which, with the new Bank Capital, will be \$800,000

Of the Banks in the City of Portland, we have reported in favor of the increase of the

Capital of the Maine Bank, by	- -	\$100,000
" of the Bank of Portland,	- -	100,000
" of the Casco Bank,	- -	100,000
" of the Exchange Bank,	- -	50,000

		\$350,000

The Bank Capital there before was 1,349,000

and with the above increase will be \$1,699,000

The Committee have also reported a bill to incorporate the Stillwater Canal Bank, at *Stillwater*, with a Capital of \$50,000, which is all the Bank Capital there is at that place.

Also, to incorporate the **Penobscot Bank**, at *Brewer*, with a Capital of \$50,000, which is the whole of the **Bank Capital** there.

Also, to incorporate the **Lincoln Central Bank**, at *Wiscasset*, with a Capital of \$50,000, which is the whole of the **Bank Capital** there.

Also, to incorporate the **Washington County Bank**, at *Calais*, with a Capital of - \$ 50,000 and to increase the Capital of the **Calais**

Bank at Calais, - - - - -	50,000
The Bank Capital at Calais before was	50,000

making the whole Capital at Calais,	\$150,000
