IN SENATE, February 4, 1836.

The Committee on State Lands to whom was referred an order instructing them to inquire and Report the probable number of Officers, Soldiers and Widows of deceased officers and soldiers of the Revolutionary War, entitled to receive grants of Land under the Resolve passed March seventeenth, eighteen hundred and thirty-five, and the number of acres of Land which may be required therefor; have had the same under consideration, and ask leave to Report :

That from the best information they can obtain, the following may be considered as very nearly correct.

The whole number whose claims have been allowed, are about three hundred and seventy-seven.

Estimated number not yet decided upon, may be about seventy-three. Whole number, four hundred and fifty.

Amount of Land appropriated, forty-five thousand, four hundred acres.

Estimated quantity required to satisfy remaining claims, forty-four thousand, six hundred acres.

Whole amount of Land required by that Resolve ninety thousand acres.
