STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND THIRTY-SIX.

AN ACT to abolish Imprisonment for Debt. [NEW DRAFT.]

SECT. 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and 2 House of Representatives in Legislature as-3 sembled, That no person shall be arrested or 4 imprisoned on any civil process issuing out of 5 any court of law, or any execution issuing out of 6 any court of law or equity, or on any suit or pro-7 ceeding instituted for the recovery of any money 8 due upon any judgment or decree, founded upon 9 contract, or due upon any contract, express or 10 implied, or for the recovery of any damages for 11 the non-performance of any contract. SECT. 2. Be it further enacted, That the 2 preceding section shall not extend to any person 3 who is not a citizen of the United States and 4 who shall not have been a resident of this State 5 for at least one year previous to the commence-6 ment of a suit against him; nor to proceedings 7 as for contempts to enforce civil remedies; nor 8 to actions for fines or penalties, or on promise to 9 marry, or for moneys collected by any public 10 officer, or for any misconduct or neglect in office 11 or in any professional employment.

SECT. 3. Be it further enacted, That this 2 Act shall take effect from and after the fourth 3 day of July next, and all acts and parts of acts 4 inconsistent with the provisions of this Act, be 5 and the same are hereby repealed from and after 6 the time aforesaid.
