
### STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND THIRTY-EIGHT.

## AN ADDITIONAL ACT concerning the Public Money apportioned to the State of Maine.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and 2 House of Representatives in Legislature assem-3 bled, That the several Cities, Towns, and Plan-4 tations in this State, are released and exonerated 5 from all obligation imposed on them by an Act 6 entitled an Act providing for the disposition and 7 repayment of the Public money apportioned to the 8 State of Maine on deposite, by the Government 9 of the United States, passed March eighth, in the 10 year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and 11 thirty-seven; to restore or pay over to the State 12 the sums of money respectively deposited with 13 them by virtue of said Act, and they are hereby au-14 thorized and empowered at any legal meeting called 15 for that purpose, to distribute the same, "per cap-16 *ita*," among the inhabitants of such Cities, Towns, 17 and Plantations, or otherwise dispose of the same 18 as they shall see fit.

SEC. 2. Be it further enacted, That all Acts 2 and parts of Acts inconsistent with the provisions 3 of this Act be and are hereby repealed.
