STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND THIRTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to prevent fraud in the Pressing of Hay.

Sect. 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House

- 2 of Representatives in Legislature assembled,
- 3 That all Hay which shall be pressed or put up in
- 4 bundles for sale within this state after the first day
- 5 of May next, shall be branded upon the crate en-
- 6 closing the same, with the first letter of the Chris-
- 7 tian name and the whole of the surname of the per-
- 3 son packing and screwing, or otherwise pressing
- 9 said Hay, or causing the same to be done, and with
- 10 the town where said Hay shall be pressed, and
- 11 with the name of the State.
 - Sect. 2. All pressed Hay which shall be of-
 - 2 fered for sale or for shipping, without being brand-
 - 3 ed as aforesaid, shall be forfeited, one half to the
 - 4 person or persons prosecuting therefor, and the oth-
 - 5 er half to the use of the City, Town, or Plantation,

6 where said Hay shall be so offered for sale or for 7 shipping.

SECT. 3. Any master or commander of any ves-2 sel which shall take on board pressed Hay, not 3 branded as aforesaid, shall forfeit and pay the sum 4 of two dollars for each and every bundle of Hay so 5 received—one half to the use of the person or per-6 sons prosecuting therefor, and one half to the use 7 of the City, Town or Plantation, where said Hay

8 shall be received on board.
