#### STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVES in favor of certain Commissioned officers, and others, of the Revolutionary War, and the Widows of such persons.

Resolved, That each Commissioned officer of 2 the Revolutionary Army, who actually served not 3 less than three years in said Army, and who, at 4 the commencement of such service, was an inhab-5 itant of Massachusetts Proper, or of the District 6 of Maine, and is now an inhabitant of this State, 7 and who has not already received a grant of land, 8 or money in lieu thereof, from the Commonwealth 9 of Massachusetts, and each widow of such officer, 10 who at the time of his disease, was an inhabitant 11 of this State, shall be entitled to receive six hun-12 dred acres of land, to be selected from Letter 13 in the second Range of Townships, West of the 14 East line of the State, in the County of Washing-15 ton.—And each officer, who was honorably dis-16 charged before the expiration of three years from 17 the time of his entering the service in consequence

13 of wounds received in the service, or other bodily 19 infirmity, and each widow of such officer, and 20 the widow of each officer, who died in the service 21 within three years from the time of his entering in 22 the same, shall, if in all other respects coming 23 within the provisions of this Resolve, be entitled 24 to receive a like grant of land to be selected as 25 aforesaid.

Resolved, That the Land Agent is hereby au-2 thorised and directed to cause the said Township, 3 as soon as may be, to be surveyed and laid out into 4 convenient lots of six hundred acres each; and to 5 execute a conveyance of one lot to every officer and 6 widow aforesaid, who shall from his or her claims 7 to the satisfaction of the Land Agent on or before 8 the fourth day of March, in the year of our Lord 9 one thousand eight hundred and forty. And every 10 such officer or widow, who shall establish his or 11 her claim as aforesaid before the survey of the land 12 shall be completed, shall be entitled to receive 13 from the Land Agent a certificate stating that he or 14 she is entitled to six hundred acres of land under 15 the provisions of these Resolves, which certificate 16 shall be conclusive evidence to entitle the lawful 17 holder thereof to a conveyance in fee simple of one 18 of the six hundred acre lots aforesaid, whenev-19 er said land shall be surveyed and laid out as 20 herein provided. And it shall be the duty of the

21 Land Agent to number said lots, to be surveyed 22 and laid out as aforesaid, from number one up-23 wards, and place the numbers in a box to be kept 24 for that purpose, and each person, who shall be 25 entitled to a lot under the provisions of these Re-26 solves shall, in person or by Agent, draw one 27 number therefrom, which shall represent the lot to 23 which such person may be entitled.

Resolved, That the Land Agent is hereby au-2 thorised to procure at the expense of the State, 3 from the Land Agent and Secretary of the Com-4 monwealth of Massachusetts, and from the Pen-5 sion Office at Washington, certified copies of all 6 such documents and records as he may deem ne-7 cessary or useful in carrying into effect the provis-8 ions of these Resolves. And it shall be his duty 9 to keep correct plans of all surveys, which shall 10 be made as aforesaid, and to mark upon each lot 11 the name of the person who shall draw the same, 12 and also to keep a record of the names and places 13 of abode of and such other material circumstances 14 relating to the several claimants as may be deemed 15 necessary to obviate all disputes respecting the 16 justice of their claims.

Resolved, That every officer and widow, who 2 become the owner of land under the provisions of 3 these Resolves, shall hold the same exempt from 4 attachment on mesne process or Execution.
