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## STATE OF MAINE.



IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND THIRTY-EIGHT.

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AN ACT additional to an Act to promote the sale  
and settlement of the Public Lands.

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SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House  
2 of Representatives in Legislature assembled, That  
3 the Land Agent is hereby authorised and empow-  
4 ered to sell and convey any township or townships  
5 of land, which in the opinion of said Agent, the  
6 Surveyor General, and the Governor and Council,  
7 shall be more valuable for settling than for tim-  
8 ber, at a price to be fixed by said Land Agent, not  
9 less than fifty cents per acre, upon a credit of five  
10 years ; and the condition of said sale shall be, that  
11 the sum of two hundred dollars, until said land  
12 shall be paid for, shall be allowed to the purcha-  
13 ser or purchasers of said township, for every per-*

14 son, who shall within said five years, take up a  
15 lot in said township, and perform the settling du-  
16 ties as now required by law.

SECT. 2. *Be it further enacted,* That a fur-  
2 ther condition in said sale shall be, that said pur-  
3 chaser or purchasers within one year from the  
4 time of selecting said township, shall cause the  
5 same to be surveyed and run out into lots, in the  
6 manner now prescribed by law, by the Surveyor  
7 General, or under his direction, at the expense of  
8 said purchaser or purchasers.

SECT. 3. *Be it further enacted,* That from  
2 and after the passage of this Act, all Acts and  
3 parts of Acts inconsistent with the provisions of  
4 this Act, be, and the same are hereby repealed.
