STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-NINE.

AN ACT additional to "An Act respecting the
offices and duties of the Attorney General and
County Attornies."

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of
2 Representatives in Legislature assembled,*

3 That the several County Attornies in this State
4 shall receive each, an annual salary as follows :

5 For the County of York, two hundred dol-
6 lars,

7 For the County of Cumberland, five hundred
8 dollars,

9 For the County of Oxford, one hundred and
10 fifty dollars,

2 SALARIES OF COUNTY ATTORNIES, &c. [JAN,

11 For the County of Lincoln, four hundred
12 dollars,

13 For the County of Kennebec, four hundred
14 dollars,

15 For the County of Somerset, two hundred
16 dollars,

17 For the County of Penobscot, six hundred
18 dollars,

19 For the County of Hancock, one hundred
20 and fifty dollars,

21 For the County of Waldo, one hundred and
22 fifty dollars,

23 For the County of Washington, three hun-
24 dred dollars,

25 For the County of Franklin, one hundred
26 dollars,

27 For the County of Piscataquis, one hundred
28 dollars,

29 to be paid to them severally out of the Treasury
30 of the State, in equal quarterly payments in full
31 for all services rendered by them, and in lieu of
32 all fees heretofore received by them, except that
33 they shall each be entitled to receive out of the
34 County Treasury the same fees as are now pro-

35 vided by law for their travel and attendance
36 before juries and committees appointed to esti-
37 mate damages sustained by reason of the laying
38 out of highways.

SECT. 2. *Be it further enacted,* That said
2 Attornies, shall severally in the month of No-
3 vember in each year, make reports to the Attor-
4 ney General of the amount and kind of official
5 business by them done respectively in the year
6 preceding; the number of persons prosecuted, the
7 offences for which such prosecutions were had,
8 the results thereof and the punishment awarded
9 in such case, with such other particular statements
10 or suggestions as they may deem interesting to
11 be known. And it shall be the duty of the
12 Attorney General in the month of December in
13 each year to make a report to the Governor and
14 Council of a like kind as those required of
15 County Attornies, which report shall also con-
16 tain an abstract of the several reports made to
17 him by the County Attornies.
