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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT  
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-NINE.

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### AN ADDITIONAL ACT concerning Cor- porations.

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SEC. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and  
2 House of Representatives in Legislature  
3 assembled, That so much of an act entitled  
4 " An Act concerning Corporations," approved  
5 February 16, 1836, as limits the liability of  
6 stockholders in Corporations, in their individual  
7 capacity, for corporate debts to the amount  
8 of stock owned by them respectively, be and  
9 the same hereby is repealed : Provided, That  
10 the provisions of this act shall not be construed  
11 to apply to Banking Corporations, or Corpora-  
12 tions granted for literary or benevolent purposes,  
13 nor to any Corporation established before the  
14 time when this act shall take effect.*

SEC. 2. *Be it further enacted,* That this  
2 act shall take effect and be in force from and  
3 after its approval by the Governor.
