#### STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND THIRTY-NINE.

AN ACT to provide in part for the expenditures of Government.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House 2 of Representatives in Legislature assembled, 3 That in order to provide for the operation 4 of certain Acts and Resolves of the Legislature, requiring the payment of money from 6 the Treasury, [and also to provide for the 7 necessary expenditures of the Government for 8 the current year, the following sums be, and the 9 same are hereby appropriated, to be paid out of 10 any moneys in the Treasury, the same to be in 11 lieu of all other existing appropriations what-12 ever, and the Governor with advice of the 13 Council, is hereby authorized at any time prior
