IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED

AND THIRTY-NINE.

AN AC Γ giving discretionary powers to the Supreme Judicial Court, in cases of Divorce.

Sec. 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and

2 House of Representatives in Legislature

3 assembled, That the Justices of the Supreme

4 Judicial Court, be, and hereby are, authorized

5 and empowered, at any full term of said Court,

6 all the Justices of said Court being present, and

7 all agreeing, to decree Divorces in all cases not

8 provided for by law, when, in their opinion, the

9 peace, happiness and well being of the parties

10 applying therefor, will be thereby promoted,

11 and no injury done to public morals, or the best

12 interests of the community.

Sec. 2. Be it further enacted, That the said

2 Justices may, at their discretion, decree alimony

3 in all such cases of divorce:-And this Act

4 shall take effect, and be in force, from and after

5 it shall be approved by the Governor.
