IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND FORTY.

AN ACT to provide in part for the expenditures of Government.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of

2 Representatives in Legislature assembled,
3 That in order to provide for the operation of
4 certain Acts and Resolves of the Legislature
5 requiring the payment of money from the
6 Treasury, and also to provide for the necessary
7 expenditures of the Government for the current
8 year, the following sums, be, and the same are
9 hereby appropriated, to be paid out of any
10 moneys in the Treasury, the same to be in lieu
11 of all other existing appropriations whatsoever.
12 And the Governor with advice of the Council,
13 is hereby authorized at any time prior to the

14 first day of January next, to draw his warrants15 upon the Treasurer for the same.
