

#### STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND FORTY-ONE.

AN ACT amending the nineteenth section of the one hundred and twenty-fifth chapter of the Revised Statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Rep2 resentatives in Legislature assembled, That when
3 such mortgagee or person claiming under him,
4 being out of the State, or whose residence is
5 unknown, shall have proceeded according to the
6 provisions of the fifth section of this chapter, for
7 the purpose of foreclosure, the mortgagor, or other
8 person having a right to redeem, may file his bill
9 or petition, as provided in section sixteen, and may
10 at the same time pay to the clerk of the court the
11 sum due, and the court shall order such notice to
12 be given as they may judge proper; and such pay13 ment shall have the like effect and force, as a ten14 der of payment made before the commencement of
15 the suit.
