IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND FORTY-ONE.

AN ACT to provide in part for the expenditures of Government.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Rep-2 resentatives in Legislature assembled, That in 3 order to provide for the operation of certain Acts 4 and Resolves of the Legislature, requiring the 5 payment of money from the Treasury, and also to 6 provide for the necessary expenditures of the 7 Government for the current year, the following 8 sums be, and the same are hereby appropriated, 9 to be paid out of any monies in the Treasury ; the 10 same to be in lieu of all other existing appropria-11 tions whatever. And the Governor, with advice 12 of the Council, is hereby authorized, at any time 13 prior to the first day of January next, to draw his 14 warrants upon the Treasury for the same.
