STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of William Emerson.

RESOLVED, That the Land Agent be, and he
2 hereby is authorized to receive from William
3 Emerson a conveyance of three-eighths of Township
4 number three in the thirteenth Range, west of the
5 east line of the State. And that whenever he
6 shall be satisfied that the State have a perfect title
7 to the same, he is hereby authorized to cancel and
8 deliver to said Emerson the promissory notes of
9 the said Emerson now in the Land Office, which
10 were given by said Emerson to the State for the
11 township aforesaid.
