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**RESOLVES**

IN FAVOR OF

**MAINE WESLEYAN SEMINARY.**

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STATE OF MAINE.

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RESOLVES in favor of Maine Wesleyan  
Seminary.

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*Resolved,* That there be and hereby is granted  
2 one half Township of good timber land; (the whole  
3 Township to be six miles square,) to the Trustees  
4 of the Maine Wesleyan Seminary, to be vested in  
5 them and their successors in office forever, for the  
6 use, benefit, and purpose of supporting said Sem-  
7 inary, to be by them holden in their corporate ca-  
8 pacity, with full power and authority to manage  
9 said half Township, or to sell, convey or dispose of  
10 the same, or any part thereof, in any way and man-  
11 ner that will best promote the welfare of said Sem-  
12 inary. Provided however, that no grant is hereby  
13 made to said Seminary, unless it shall raise by sub-  
14 scriptions, or donations the sum of five thousand  
15 dollars within two years from the passage of this  
16 Resolve.

*Resolved,* That when the conditions of the above  
2 Resolve are complied with, the Governor and  
3 Council are hereby authorized to select or cause

4 to be selected such half Township of timber land  
5 as they may deem most suitable for said Seminary,  
6 and the Land Agent is hereby authorized and di-  
7 rected to convey to said Trustees and their succes-  
8 sors, such half Township as the Governor and  
9 Council may select or cause to be selected for said  
10 Seminary. Provided however, that said half  
11 Township shall be liable to the building and re-  
12 pairing roads and highways, as it would be if con-  
13 veyed to, or owned by an individual.
