# STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND FORTY-TWO.

---

AN ACT granting proprietors of certain lands forfeited to the State for the nonpayment of taxes further time to redeem the same.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled,* That claimants of any lands forfeited to the State of Maine, by the operation of an act passed the 17th of February, 1836, entitled "an act relative to the collection of State taxes, and assessments made by County Commissioners," or any person claiming by, through or under them, may redeem the same by paying into the Land Office, the amount for which the same may have been forfeited, together with twenty per cent. interest thereon, at any time within one year from the passage of this act and not afterwards. And such payments being made as aforesaid, the right and interest

15 of all persons to such land shall be the same as  
16 they would have been, had there been no such  
17 forfeiture aforesaid.
