SENATORIAL DISTRICTS.

STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE amendatory to the resolves passed A. D. 1841, for dividing the State into districts for the choice of Senators, and for apportioning the Representatives among the several counties, cities, towns, plantations, and classes, at the third apportionment.

Resolved, That the several towns and plantations composing the county of Waldo, together with the towns of China, Albion, Clinton, the territory north of Albion, and the Clinton gore, shall form the fifth Senatorial District, and be entitled to three Senators.

That the remaining towns in the county of Kennebec shall form the fourth Senatorial District, and be entitled to three Senators.

That the island of Matinicus and the islands contiguous thereto, shall be taken from the third Senatorial District and annexed to the sixth district.

14 That, the towns of Parsonsfield, Cornish, and
15 Limington shall be taken from the fourteenth
16 district and annexed to the first district.

17 That, the towns of Standish and Baldwin, shall
18 be taken from the fourteenth district, and annex-
19 ed to the second district.

20 That, the towns of Bridgton, Harrison, and
21 Otisfield, shall be taken from the second district
22 and annexed to the fourteenth district.

23 That, the towns of Jay and Wilton, shall be
24 taken from the thirteenth district, and annexed
25 to the fourteenth district.

26 That, the remaining towns and plantations,
27 composing the county of Franklin, except the
28 town of Carthage, shall form the thirteenth dis-
29 trict, and be entitled to one Senator.

Resolved, That such parts of the Senatorial ap-
2 portionment resolve of 1841, as are inconsistent
3 with the provisions of the above amendatory re-
4 solve, be, and the same are hereby, rescinded.
