#### STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in relation to the claims of this State for expenditures in protecting its North Eastern Boundary.

Resolved, That the Commissioners appointed 2 under a Resolve passed at this session of the 3 Legislature, "in relation to the North Eastern 4 Boundary of this State," be authorized and 5 directed to apply to Congress, and to insist upon 6 the reimbursement without delay, by the Gen-7 eral Government, to this State, of the expendi-8 tures made under Resolves passed January 24, 9 1839, "relating to trespassers upon the Public 10 Lands," and Feb. 20, 1839, entitled a "Resolve 11 for the protection of the Public Lands;" and 12 for all the expenditures, both military and civil, 13 made by this State in protecting its territory 14 against threatened foreign invasion, and the tres-15 passes upon our public lands, instigated by an 16 unfounded claim by a foreign power to a portion 17 of our territory; and all other expenditures in-

- 18 curred in carrying on the controversy in relation
- 19 to the portion of our territory brought into dis-
- 20 pute by Great Britain.

RESOLVED, That the Governor be requested to

- 2 furnish the said Commissioners with the proper
- 3 vouchers for establishing the claims of this State
- 4 for the expenditures incurred as above stated.
