IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
FORTY-THREE.

AN ACT to provide in part for the expenditures of
Government.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
tives in Legislature assembled*—as follows :

3 In order to provide for the operation of certain
4 acts and resolves of the Legislature, requiring the
5 payment of money from the treasury, and also to pro-
6 vide for the necessary expenditures of the Govern-
7 ment, for the current year, the following sums are
8 hereby appropriated, to be paid out of any moneys in
9 the Treasury ; the same to be in lieu of all other ex-
10 isting appropriations, whatever. And the Governor,
11 with advice of the Council is hereby authorized, at
12 any time prior to the first day of January next, to draw
13 his warrant upon the Treasury for the same.
