IR RELATION TO THE

BOSTON AND MAINE RAIL ROAD.



STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND FORTY-THREE.

AN ACT to unite the Maine, New Hampshire and Massachusetts Rail Road Corporation with the Boston and Maine Rail Road.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Represen-

- 2 tatives in Legislature assembled—as follows:
- 3 Section 1. The stockholders of the Maine, New
- 4 Hampshire and Massachusetts Rail Road Corpora-
- 5 tion, are hereby constituted stockholders of the Bos-
- 6 ton and Maine Rail Road, a body corporate and pol-
- 7 itic, duly constituted and existing under and by virtue
- 8 of the laws of the State of New Hampshire and
- 9 Massachusetts; and the stockholders of said Boston
- 10 and Maine Rail Road are hereby constituted stock-
- 11 holders of the said Maine, New Hampshire and Mas-
- 12 sachusetts Rail Road Corporation, and the said two
- 13 corporations are hereby made one corporation, by
- 14 the name of the Boston and Maine Rail Road; and
- 15 all the franchises, property, powers and privileges,
- 16 granted or acquired under the authority of the said
- 17 States respectively, shall be held and enjoyed by all

- 18 the said stockholders, in proportion to the number of
- 19 shares or amount of property held by them respec-
- 20 tively, in either or both of said corporations.
 - Sec. 2. One or more of the directors or other offi-
 - 2 cers of said Boston and Maine Rail Road, shall, at
 - 3 all times, be an inhabitant of this State, on whom
 - 4 process against said company may be legally served;
 - 5 and said company may be held to answer in the ju-
 - 6 risdiction where the service is made, and the process
 - 7 is returnable.
 - Sec. 3. The said company shall keep separate ac-
 - 2 counts of their expenditures in Maine, New Hamp-
 - 3 shire and Massachusetts, respectively; and three
 - 4 commissioners shall be appointed, one by the Gov-
 - 5 ernor of each State, to hold their offices for the term
 - 6 of four years, and to be reasonably compensated by
 - 7 said company, who shall decide what portion of the
 - 8 expenditures of said company, and of its receipts
 - 9 and profits, properly pertain to that part of the road
- 10 lying in Maine, New Hampshire and Massachusetts,
- 11 respectively: and the annual report required to be
- 12 made by the directors to the Legislature of this State,
- 13 shall be approved by the said commissioners.
 - Sec. 4. The said company and the stockholders
 - 3 therein, so far as their road is situated in Maine, shall
 - 4 be subject to all the duties and liabilities of the
 - 5 Maine, New Hampshire and Massachusetts Rail Road
 - 6 Corporation, and the general laws of this State, to
 - 7 the same extent as the Maine, New Hampshire and

- 8 Massachusetts Rail Road Corporation, and the stock-
- 9 holders therein would have been if this act had not 10 passed.
 - Sec. 5. This act shall not take effect until the
 - 2 same, and also an act of the Legislatures of New
 - 3 Hampshire and Massachusetts respectively, authoriz-
 - 4 ing the union of the said corporations, shall have
 - 5 been accepted by the stockholders of the said two
 - 6 corporations respectively, at legal meetings called for
 - 7 that purpose.
