### STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND FORTY-THREE.

AN ACT to provide in part for the expenditures of Government.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-2 tives in Legislature assembled—as follows: In order to provide for the operation of certain 3 4 Acts and Resolves of the Legislature, requiring the 5 payment of money from the Treasury, and also to 6 provide for the necessary expenditures of the Govern-7 ment, for the current year, the following sums are 8 hereby appropriated, to be paid out of any moneys 9 in the Treasury; the same to be in lieu of all other 10 existing appropriations whatever.
