ANACT

RELATING TO

TENANTS IN COMMON.

STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND FORTY-FOUR.

AN ACT relating to repairing buildings, owned by tenants in common.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-2 sentatives in Legislature assembled—as follows:

3 SECTION 1. In all cases, where any tenant in 4 common of a building has a right to repair the same, 5 at the common law, the tenant, making the repairs, 6 shall have a lien upon such building and the land on 7 which it is placed against any part owner, his heirs 8 or assigns, until he shall be reimbursed for said re-9 pairs, out of the rents of said building, or until the 10 same shall otherwise be paid.

SEC. 2. Any part owner, desirous of having the 2 amount of said repairs ascertained, and the propor-3 tions of the several tenants established, may petition 4 the district court for that purpose, in the district 5 where said building is located, and said court shall 6 give due notice to the parties interested, and shall 7 determine the amount and proportions aforesaid, and 8 shall have power to award costs in such cases as it

9 may deem proper, and said lien shall continue until 10 the proportions are paid, as aforesaid.

SEC. 3. But nothing in this act shall be construed 2 to restrain any tenant in common, making repairs, 3 from pursuing the remedies given by the common law.

AMENDMENT.

Amend by inserting,

SEC 4. No tenant in common shall hereafter be 2 authorized to make any repairs on any building own-3 ed in common by himself and another or others, ex-4 cept such as may be necessary for the preservation of 5 such building, and to keep it in a tenantable condi-6 tion, without the consent of his co-tenant or co-ten-7 ants.
