ANACT

RELATING TO THE

LIABILITIES OF SHIP OWNERS.



STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND FORTY-FOUR.

AN ACT relating to the liabilities of ship owners.

Be it enacted by the Senute and House of Represen-

- 2 tatives in Legislature assembled—as follows:
- 3 In no case shall the owner or master of any ship or
- 4 vessel registered, or enrolled and licensed to carry on
- 5 the coasting trade, steam vessels excepted, be held to
- 6 answer as a common carrier for any loss happening
- 7 to property shipped on board, or taken in charge, to
- 8 be shipped on board any such vessel, where ordinary
- 9 care and diligence had been used, and which loss was
- 10 occasioned by the act of God, the public enemy, fire,
- 11 pirates, robbers, theft or rats, or any other danger,
- 12 jetson, accident, or casualty of the seas, rivers, har-
- 13 bors, or navigation of whatever nature or kind soever.

AMENDMENT PROPOSED BY MR. TUCKER OF SACO.

And nothing contained in this act shall be so construed

- 2 as to operate as an exemption from any liability to
- 3 contribution to a general average loss.
