STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND FORTY-NINE.

AN ACT to provide for the erection of a lock at the Pushaw falls in Oldtown.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. William Jameson and Jonathan A. 2 Cushing their associates and assigns are hereby au-3 thorized to construct and maintain a lock or locks in 4 the Penobscot river, at or near Pushaw falls in Old-5 town, and build a dam or dams across said river to 6 flow out said falls, to facilitate the transportation of 7 logs and lumber down said river, *provided* that all 8 persons who may have occasion to pass over the

9 dam with their logs or lumber may so do free of 10 charge; and the said Jameson and Cushing their 11 associates and assigns are authorized to take such 12 land or property as may be necessary, upon which to 13 locate their said lock or locks, by paying to the owner 14 of the same such sum as the parties may agree upon; 15 and in case they do not agree, such damages as may 16 be ascertained and determined by the county com-17 missioners of Penobscot county under the same con-18 ditions and limitations as are by law provided in the 19 case of laying out public highways.

SEC. 2. A toll of six cents is granted for each and
2 every thousand feet of logs or lumber, board measure,
3 which may pass through said lock or locks.
