STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND FORTY-NINE.

AN ACT authorizing the Portland, Saco, and Portsmouth Railroad Company to lease their road.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The Portland, Saco, and Portsmouth Railroad Com-2 pany are hereby authorized and empowered to make 3 any contract, or contracts, by lease or otherwise, with 4 the Boston and Maine Railroad Company, and the 5 Eastern Railroad Company, corporations created by 6 the acts of the legislature of the Commonwealth of 7 Massachusetts for the use and maintenance of the

8 railroad and property of said corporation first men-9 tioned, upon such terms and conditions as may be 10 mutually agreed upon by the contracting parties; 11 subject to all the duties, obligations and liabilities of 12 said company by virtue of the act incorporating the 13 same and laws of the state; and reserving to the 14 state all the rights of supervision and control over 15 said corporation, which the legislature now has, under 16 the act incorporating the same, and the laws of the 17 state, and holding said corporation subject to all lia-18 bilities, it is now under by existing laws.
