*Amendment offered by Mr. Farley of Newcastle, to the  
Bill introduced by Mr. Walker.*

Amend the first section as follows :

Strike out all after the tenth line in the first section,  
and insert—

The county of Lincoln, together with the towns of  
2 Windsor, Pittston, Chelsea, Litchfield, Kennebec,  
3 Winthrop, West Gardiner, the city of Gardiner, and  
4 the city of Hallowell, from the county of Kennebec,  
5 shall compose the third district, and be entitled to one  
6 representative.

7 The county of Waldo, together with that part of  
8 the county of Kennebec, not included in the third  
9 district, shall compose the fourth district, and be en-  
10 titled to one representative.

11 The counties of Somerset and Piscataquis, together  
12 with that part of the county of Penobscot, not in-  
13 cluded in the sixth district, shall compose the fifth  
14 district, and be entitled to one representative.

15 The counties of Aroostook, Washington and Han-

16 cock, together with the towns of Orrington, Brewer,  
17 Eddington, Clifton, Bradley, Milford, Greenbush,  
18 Passadumkeag, Enfield, Lowell and Burlington, in  
19 the county of Penobscot, together with townships  
20 numbered three, four and five, in the first range, in  
21 said county, shall compose the sixth district, and be  
22 entitled to one representative.
