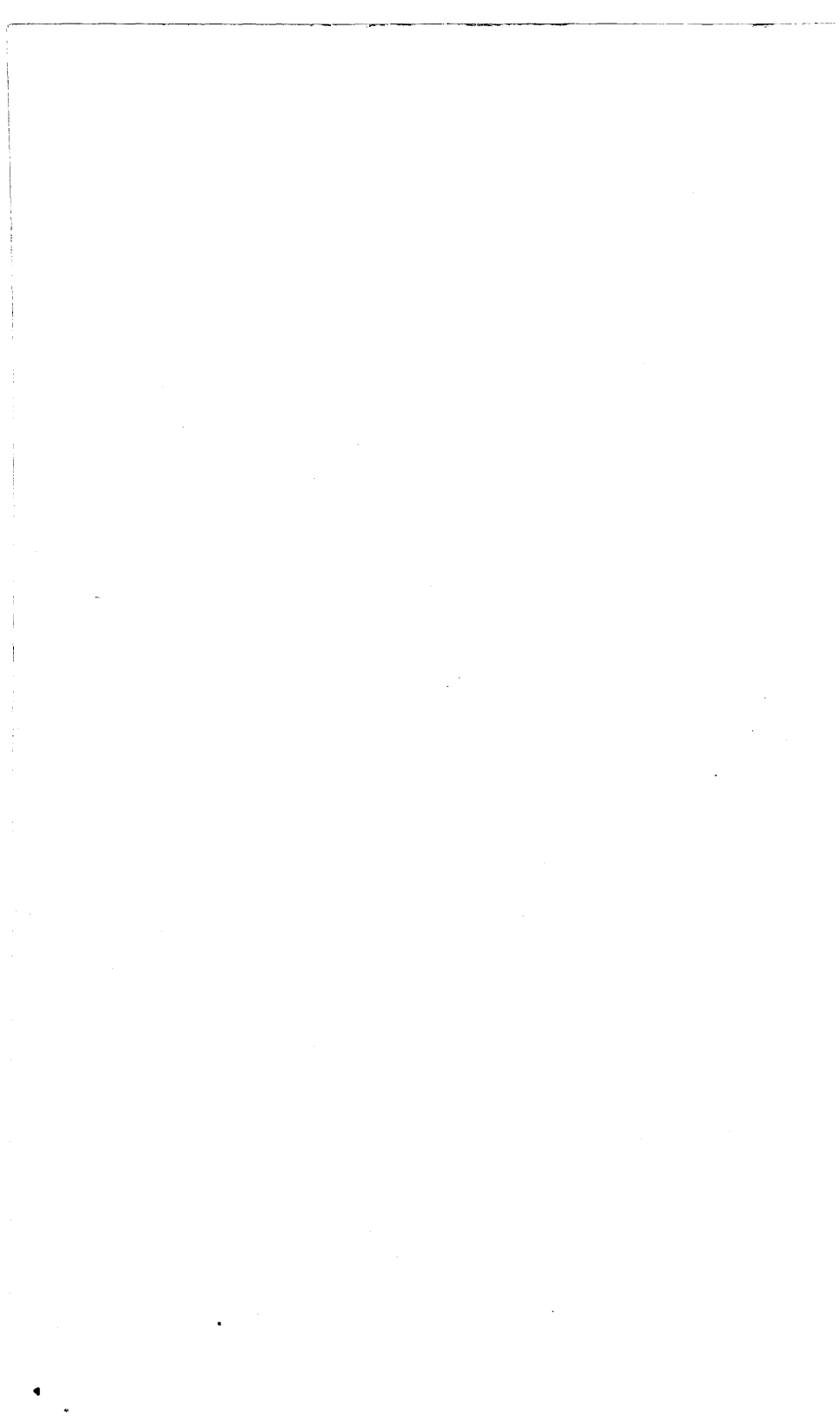

LAND OFFICE,
Augusta, March 17, 1853. }

HON. SAMUEL BUTMAN,

President of the Senate :

SIR—In answer to an order of the Senate of the 17th inst., I herewith transmit an abstract of the sales of settling lands by this State from the year 1841 to 1853.

I have no data in this office to enable me to inform the Senate in relation to the *actual* and *permanent* settlers now on these lots, which have been sold during the time mentioned in the order, but am aware that very many of these lots have not at this time any settlers on them.

In relation to the settling qualities of the undivided lands, it is difficult to say what portion of them is suitable for settlement. Of the twenty-three townships surveyed and mostly explored in 1850, lying on the upper waters of the St. John, the greater part of them is represented to be of very poor quality of soil, and of little value for agricultural purposes; and the same remark applies to many of the townships of former surveys on the lower waters of the St. John and its tributaries. Without pretending to accuracy in a matter so very difficult to determine, I give as my opinion, that about one third part of the undivided lands may be considered of fair quality for settling purposes.

The whole expense of the land office, including explorations, surveys, &c., &c., from 1840 to 1853, is \$81,319 9¢. It would be impossible to tell what portion of this sum should be placed to the account of settling lands, no distinction having been made in the expenses of the office relative to the two classes of lands.

The mere expense, however, of selling and managing the settling lands, has not been great, and would probably amount to less than one eighth part of the whole expense of this office since 1841, and a very much less proportion for the last few years, since the settling tracts have been lotted.

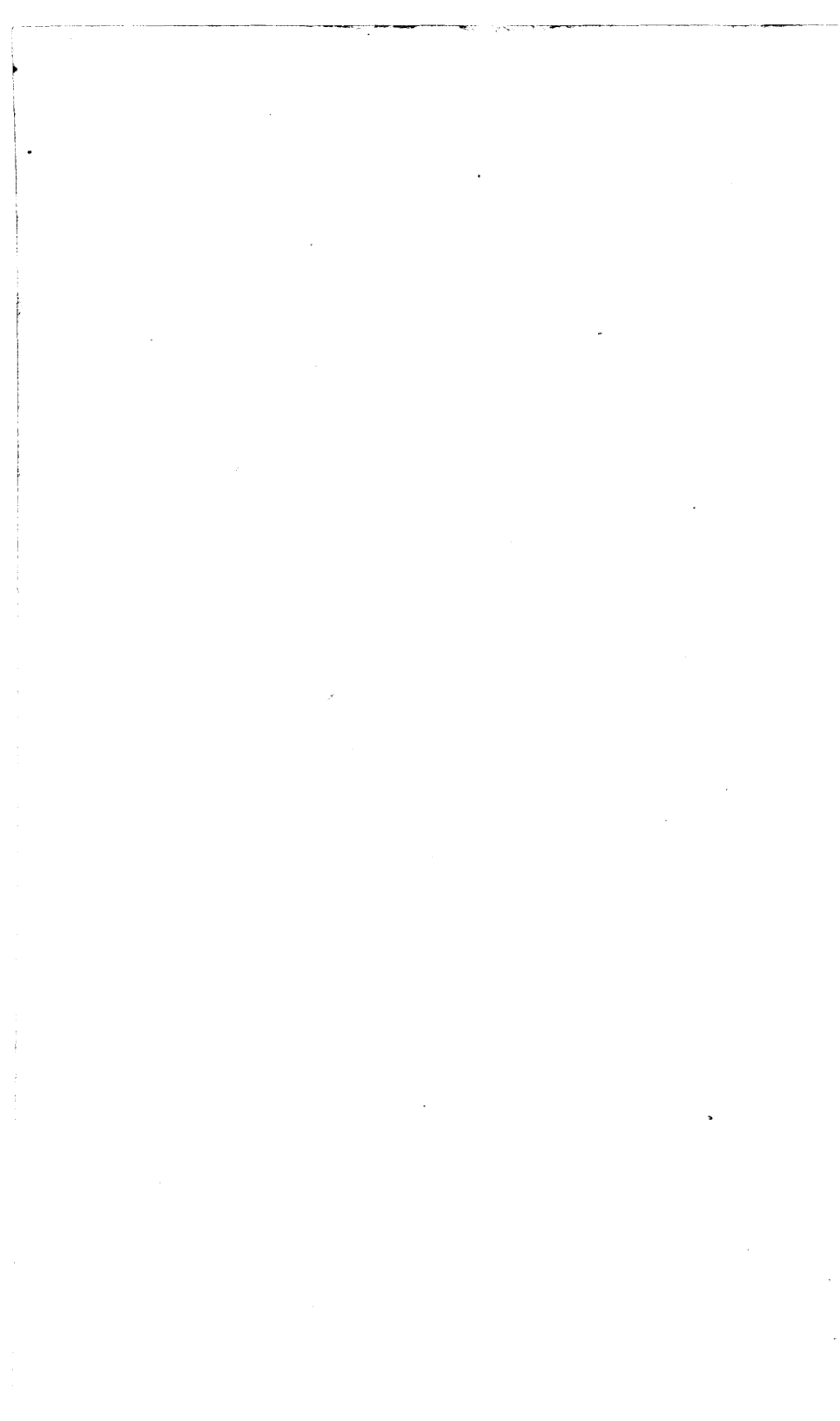
