IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
FIFTY-FOUR.

AN ACT concerning the Passamaquoddy Indians.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. There shall be paid to the Passama-
2 quoddy Indians the sum of seven hundred dollars,
3 annually, out of the fund belonging to said tribe.

SECT. 2. The agent for said tribe shall pay out said
2 money, in person, as follows : four hundred dollars
3 in the month of May, annually, and three hundred
4 dollars in the month of November, annually, in an
5 equal proportion to each member of said tribe.

SECT. 3. Sections twenty-five and twenty-seven of

2 chapter fifteenth of the revised statutes, and an act
3 concerning the Passamaquoddy Indians, approved
4 March seventh, eighteen hundred and forty-two, be
5 and the same are hereby repealed.
