STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND FIFTY-FOUR.

AN ACT to amend section twenty-two of chapter one hundred and seventy-two of the revised statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section twenty-two of chapter one

- 2 hundred and seventy-two of the revised statutes shall
- 3 be amended in line second, after the word "or," by
- 4 inserting the words "where the sentence must be,"
- 5 so that the section as amended shall read as follows:
- 6 "Any person indicted for a crime punishable with
- 7 death, or where the sentence must be by imprison-
- 8 ment in the state prison for life, shall be entitled to
- 9 have a list of the jurors returned delivered to him or

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- 10 his counsel, a copy of the indictment, and process to
- 11 summon his witnesses at the expense of the state;
- 12 all which it shall be the duty of the clerk to furnish
- 13 without expense to the prisoner."
 - SECT. 2. This act shall take effect from and after 2 its approval by the governor.
