IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND FIFTY-FIVE.

RESOLVE in favor of Waterville College.

Resolved, That whenever it shall be made to appear
2 to the Governor and Council, that the Trustees of
3 Waterville College, located at Waterville, have actually
4 raised by private subscriptions, a sum not less than
5 fifteen thousand dollars, for the use of said College,
6 they shall certify that fact to the Land Agent of the
7 State, and he is hereby authorized and directed, upon
8 the receipt of said certificate, to convey to said Trus-
9 tees, for the purposes of aid to said College, two half
10 townships of land, to be selected by said Trustees from
11 any lands belonging to the State; or in lieu of said
12 land, the Governor and Council, in their discretion,

13 may draw their warrant on the Treasury in favor of
14 said Trustees for such a sum of money, as in their
15 opinion, shall be a fair equivalent for said two half
16 townships of land.
