STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND FIFTY-FIVE.

AN ACT additional to Chapter 125 of the Revised Statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Whenever a debt has been or hereafter

- 2 shall be contracted, for labor performed or materials
- 3 furnished for or on account of the construction, alter-
- 4 ation or repair of, or for provisions or stores, or other
- 5 articles furnished for or on account of any ship or
- 6 vessel within this State, such debt is and shall be, a
- 7 lien upon such ship or vessel, her tackle, apparel and
- 8 furniture, and shall be preferred to all other liens
- 9 thereon, except mariners' wages.

- SECT. 2. When the ship or vessel shall depart from 2 the port at which she was, when such debt was con-3 tracted, to some other port or place within this State, 4 every such debt shall cease to be a lien at the expira-
- 5 tion of twenty days after the day of such departure;
- 6 and in all cases such lien shall cease immediately after
- 7 the vessel shall have arrived in any port out of this
- 8 State.
- SECT. 3. The said lien may be secured by an 2 attachment on said vessel within the time herein-3 before provided, which attachment shall have prece-4 dence of all other attachments, claims or conveyances; 5 and the same proceedings shall be had in such actions 6 as are provided in chapter seventy-eight of the act 7 entitled "an act in relation to the lien of mechanics
- SECT. 4. The thirty-fifth section of chapter one 2 hundred and twenty-five of the Revised Statutes is 3 hereby repealed, saving and excepting all actions and 4 proceedings now pending thereon.

Sect. 5. This act shall take effect from and after 2 its approval by the Governor.
