IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND FIFTY-FIVE.

RESOLVE in favor of Westbrook Seminary.

Resolved, That the Land Agent be and he hereby is
2 authorized and required to convey to the Trustees of
3 the Westbrook Seminary, at Westbrook, for the pur-
4 pose of endowing a Department of Natural Science,
5 in said Seminary, two half Townships of the unap-
6 propriated lands of said State, to be selected by said
7 Trustees: or in lieu of said land, the Governor and
8 Council, in their discretion, may draw their warrant
9 on the Treasury in favor of said Trustees for such
10 a sum of money, as in their opinion shall be a fair
11 equivalent for said two half townships of land—

12 three-fourths of the proceeds of said lands, or money,
13 to be permanently invested by said Trustees for the
14 payment of instruction in said Department, the
15 remainder to be invested, or appropriated, in such
16 manner as in the discretion of said Trustees will best
17 conduce to advance the interests and usefulness of
18 said institution.
