IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND FIFTY-FIVE.

RESOLVE in favor of Maine Wesleyan Seminary.

Resolved, That whenever it shall be made to appear

- 2 to the Governor and Council that the Trustees of the
- 3 Maine Wesleyan Seminary at Readfield, have actually
- 4 raised, by private subscriptions, a sum not less than
- 5 ten thousand dollars, for the use of said Seminary,
- 6 they shall certify that fact to the Land Agent of the
- 7 State, and he is hereby authorized and directed, upon
- 8 the receipt of said certificate, to convey to said Trus-
- 9 tees for the purpose of establishing a "Female Col-
- 10 legiate Institute," two half townships of land, to be
- 11 selected by said Trustees from any lands belonging to

12 the State: or in lieu of said land, the Governor and

13 Council, in their discretion, may draw their warrant

14 on the Treasury in favor of said Trustees for such

15 a sum of money as, in their opinion, shall be a fair

16 equivalent for said two half townships of land.
