
AN ACT in relation to the powers of constables.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. The power of any constable to serve
- 2 process in personal actions where the debt or damage
- 3 sued for, or recovered, exceeds one hundred dollars,
- 4 shall be suspended whenever and so long as a sheriff
- 5 or qualified deputy sheriff resides in the city or town
- 6 by which such constable was chosen or appointed,
- 7 except as to process in the hands of such constable
- 8 at the time his powers become suspended by the
- 9 operation of this act.

Sect. 2. This act shall be in force from and after 2 its approval by the governor.
