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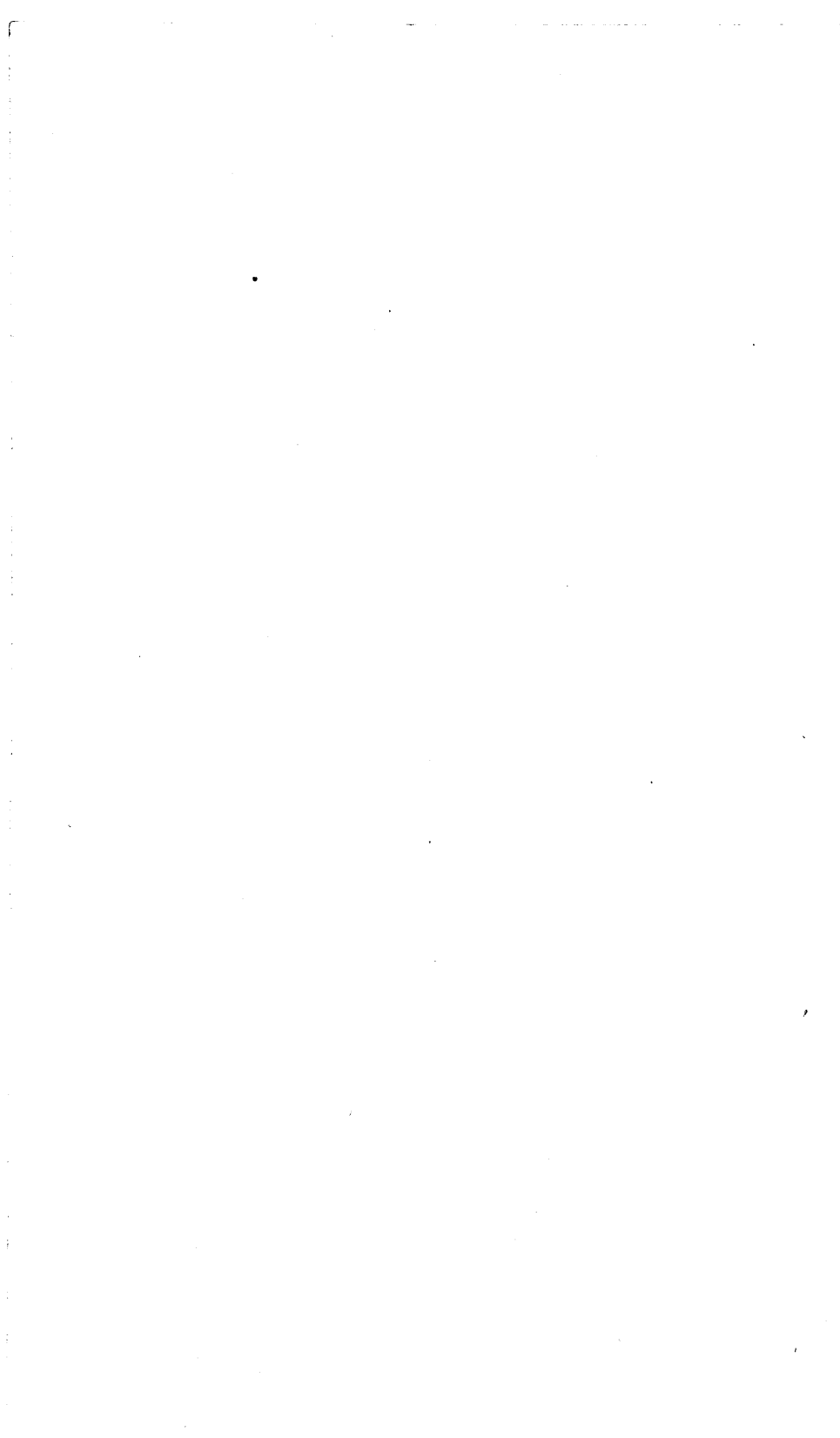
### AN ACT in relation to the powers of constables.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. The power of any constable to serve  
2 process in personal actions where the debt or damage  
3 sued for, or recovered, exceeds one hundred dollars,  
4 shall be suspended whenever and so long as a sheriff  
5 or qualified deputy sheriff resides in the city or town  
6 by which such constable was chosen or appointed,  
7 except as to process in the hands of such constable  
8 at the time his powers become suspended by the  
9 operation of this act.

SECT. 2. This act shall be in force from and after  
2 its approval by the governor.
